

Thanks to your willingness to share your knowledge, we are offering significant sessions on useful developments on the use of technology in taxation, as well as a special vendor Solutions Series.


Some of you will be attending our E-STANDARDS working group meeting after the close of the Conference, which will focus on developing XML-based state and federal electronic commerce standards.




White River Conference Level
