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ANNUAL PUBLIC HEARING

Commissioner Krupp's first annual public hearing with DOR was one year ago. During that hearing he stated, "Sometimes we need to bear things we don't like ... Listening and learning are the first steps in making things better across the agency – for taxpayers and our employees." He also made it clear that the department would address all issues brought forward by the members of the public who spoke that day.
